

PLACE AND TRAIN PROGRAMMES FACTSHEET

(A) What are Place-and-Train Programmes?

1. Place and Train (PnT) programmes provide training and salary support to help rank-and-file (RnF) workers reskill to take on new jobs in different sectors. Eligible applicants will be hired by participating employers before undergoing training to take on new job roles. The duration of the PnT programme will depend on the job and training requirements.

2. To encourage employers to hire and reskill unemployed Singapore Citizens (SCs) who have been unemployed for 6 months or more, enhanced salary support will be provided for them with effect from 1 April 2018 (see [Table 1](#)).

Table 1: Funding Rates for PnT Programme

Funding to Employers by WSG	Support Rate
Course Fee Funding	<i>Up to 90% of course fees</i>
Salary Support	<i>Up to 70% of monthly salary, pay-out capped at \$2,000 per month*</i>
[New] Salary Support for LTU¹ (For SCs Only)	<i>Up to 90% of monthly salary, pay-out capped at \$3,000 per month[#]</i>

* Funding caps may apply

Effective 1 April 2018, funding caps may apply

(B) Who is eligible for PnT Programme?

Individuals

3. Locals who meet the following criteria can apply for the programme:
 - SC or Singapore Permanent Resident
 - minimum 21 years old

¹ Long Term Unemployed (LTU) is defined as being unemployed and actively seeking employment for six months or more.

- Meet employer or course-specific entry criteria for each programme, where applicable
- Only SCs who are LTU will qualify for enhanced salary support rates

Employers

4. The participating company must fulfil the following criteria:
 - Registered or incorporated in Singapore
 - Able to offer employment directly related to the job which the programme is for, with remuneration that is commensurate with the market rate
 - Commit to the training arrangements for the individuals whom they have selected
