Annex C: Media Factsheet on SGUnited Jobs and Skills Centres

The SGUnited Jobs and Skills Centres are satellite career centres which have been set up at community touchpoints in all HDB towns to complement the existing network of main career services centres operated by Workforce Singapore (WSG), NTUC's Employment and Employability Institute (e2i) centres, as well as WSG-appointed career matching partners

The Government has created a wider range of opportunities for jobseekers through the SGUnited Jobs and Skills Package, and these satellite career centres complement these efforts by bringing those opportunities closer to jobseekers, providing information on jobs and training, and helping them find what will help them most based on their needs.

The 24 SGUnited Jobs and Skills Centres are staffed by WSG Career Ambassadors, who are on hand to provide personalised career advisory and guidance on the SGUnited Jobs and Skills Package, as well as refer jobseekers who need more in-depth career coaching to the nearest main career centre.

Compared to Careers Connect On-the-Go, a mobile setup deployed into the heartlands for shorter terms of up to a week, the SGUnited Jobs and Skills Centres help to establish a longer-term presence deeper within the heartlands so that jobseekers are able to receive career services at places nearer their homes.

The 24 locations will be implemented in phases:
