OneAviation Careers & Education Fair (OAC) 2025

OAC 2025 will open from 10am to 6pm from 18 to 19 July at Suntec City Convention Centre, Halls 403 and 404. Over 40 exhibitors comprising aviation employers, aviation educational institutions and partner organisations are on-site to showcase the best aviation has to offer to Singapore and Singaporeans. The event is organised by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS), in partnership with the NTUC, NTUC's Employment and Employability Institute (e2i), Workforce Singapore (WSG) and SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG).

2 Themed, "One Industry, Many Opportunities", OAC 2025 spotlights the diverse roles that aviation workers play to keep our bustling air hub running and aims to broaden and deepen awareness of the many career opportunities available in the aviation sector.

3 This year, key highlights include:

a) Drone Soccer

In partnership with the Association of Drone Soccer Singapore (ADSS), drone soccer makes a landing at the OAC 2025. On 18 July, volunteers from the ADSS will guide visitors on how to operate the drones and play drone soccer, and 19 July, there will be a competition amongst students. Spectators can watch the high-octane drone chases and watch them score goals!

b) X'periential Zone

Visitors can experience flight simulators, games, virtual and augmented reality at the various stations curated by our aviation educational institutions.



Young students and aspiring aviators can find out more about aviation education pathways and programmes, and skills upgrading opportunities by engaging with the educators from several institutes of higher learning at the Zone.

c) Aviator's Journey: Perspectives from Industry Insiders

Visitors will also be able to connect with aviation professionals such as pilots, cabin crew, aircraft engineers and more, in a specially curated setting that promotes meaningful interactions. Each session features two professionals from two different aviation fields, joined by a moderator, to explore how their roles intersect and complement each other. These professionals will share their personal journey in the world of aviation, including wacky anecdotes and exciting situations they have encountered at work. d) Recruitment & Career Guidance Fair

Jointly organised with NTUC's e2i and WSG, job seekers and aviation enthusiasts seeking a career in aviation can participate in walk-in interviews for more than 1,500 vacancies available across 16 participating aviation employers, as well as obtain personalised career coaching and guidance on job search strategies such as interview preparation, resume writing, and career planning tips. Jobs are available in the areas of corporate and services, operations and engineering (refer below for the list of employers conducting on-site interviews).
