## JOB SEARCHES MADE SIMPLE

STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESSFUL JOB SEARCHES, APPLICATIONS AND INTERVIEWS



#### Tips for attention-grabbing resumes

- · Tailor your resume to match each specific job that you're applying for
- Look for keywords in job postings, then tweak your resumes to meet what hiring managers are looking for
- · Use an attractive professional template and font

#### The essentials inside every resume

Profile

Your name, contact number and email address.

Skills

Include soft skills and technical skills that are relevant to the job role.

Work Experience

List your internship and part-time employment experience (if any), beginning with the most recent.

Career Summary

Show how you can add value to the organisation.

Accomplishments

Quantify your achievements in both formal and informal (i.e. voluntary or project) work.

Education & Training

List relevant educational qualifications and training courses.

#### **Acing Your Interviews**

#### Plan for your interviews

- o Physical interview:
  - Arrive at least 15 minutes before the interview
- Virtual interview:

Find a conducive location for your interview and test your equipment at least 30 minutes beforehand



#### Prepare for these common interview questions

- o Tell me more about yourself
- Why did you apply for this job?
- What is your weakness?
- Why do you want to work in this company/organisation?

#### Engage with your interviewers by asking them these questions

- What does a typical day here look like?
- What are the most important skills and attributes that someone in this role should possess?
- What are the long-term prospects for the person who fills this role?

#### Avoid doing these things

- Speaking negatively about ex-colleagues or bosses
- Answering questions with a simple "Yes" or "No"
- Bringing up or discussing personal issues or family problems

Grab the interviewer's attention with **C.A.R!** For example, if an interviewer asks,

#### "Tell me about a time when you faced challenges when doing your project"



- 1 Context
  Provide a summary of the situation or task
- 2 Action
  Elaborate on how you solved the challenge
- 3 Result
  Share the outcome, relate what you learnt to the job you're interviewing for

#### 1 Budget, budget, budget

#### 2 Automate your savings

#### 3 Start investing early

The best time to start investing is when you draw your first paycheque. By investing a small amount of your salary every month, you can leverage the principle of compounding to accumulate funds for the important things in your life.

#### Write Down

•	What are the big things in life that I'm saving for? (i.e. A home, marriage, car, retirement, etc.)	
•	What investments am I comfortable with? (i.e. Insurance, banking products, investment platforms, etc.)	

Decide on your investment platform (or product) of choice, then set it up as an automatic recurring investment.
