

# CAPABILITY TRANSFER PROGRAMME

The Capability Transfer Programme supports companies, associations or professional bodies in speeding up the transfer of capabilities from foreign specialists into Singapore. This programme will complement existing capability development programmes administered by other Government agencies, to plug capability gaps quickly in today's fast-changing global market.

Facilitating transfer of capabilities from foreign specialists to locals and encourage:

## Benefits



**A culture of pervasive capabilities transfer** across all sectors and entities

Allow companies, associations or professional bodies to **develop and acquire new capabilities in Singapore** by ensuring that there is sustainable supply of locals with the requisite skillsets

Support levels will be determined by Workforce Singapore in consultation with relevant sector agencies, on a co-funding basis where applicable, and will vary depending on the level of impact and type of entity.

Funding support can include:



**Salary support** for foreign specialists, local specialists conducting follow-on training in Singapore, or local trainees sent overseas



In the case of industry-wide projects, **funding for equipment cost and venue cost** may also be considered on a case-by-case basis



**Attachment-related costs** such as airfare and Cost of Living Allowances

## Eligibility Criteria

All project proposals will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis, taking into consideration:



existing local **capability gaps**



the **potential impact** of the transfer of capabilities to locals



**linkage** of the project to the industry as a whole
