The Workfare Skills Support (WSS) scheme supports lower-wage workers in areas of training that are likely to lead to better employment.

There are 3 funding components under WSS: Training Commitment Award (TCA), Training Allowance (TA) and Absentee Payroll (AP).

Claim Process and Conditions	 No application is required. Individuals who are eligible for WSS are eligible for TCA if they achieve the Full Qualification and/or complete eligible courses within the WSS eligibility period stated. It will take up to 3 months for TCA to be disbursed. Individuals will be notified of their TCA payment via SMS and/or letter by CPF Board. 	 If you are an employee with regular CPF contributions: No application is required. If you are eligible for TA, it will be credited to your PayNow registered (NRIC-linked) bank account in 1 to 5 months after course completion. If you are self-employed and do not have regular CPF contributions: Submit your TA claim online via your Singpass at https://go.gov.sg/wss-sep-ta and provide documents to prove active employment within 4 months from your course end date. If you are eligible for TA, it will be credited to your PayNow registered (NRIC-linked) bank account within 3 months from your claim submission.
